Clay, sand, gravel, pebbles, cobbles, and boulders are used in making buildings, streets, bricks, playgrounds, sidewalks, and decorations

## How are bricks made?



• Clay mixes with water and earth materials to harden.

## What is soil?



Soil is the top layer of the earth where plants anchor their roots to get water and nutrients. Soil is made of humus and earth materials: sand, clay, silt, gravel, and pebbles.

How do magnets work?



Magnets stick to objects that are made or iron or steel. Being magnetic is a property of an object.
